

Shorewood High School Science Department Policies

Attendance Policy:

On the 9th absence (excused or unexcused) in a semester, the student will lose credit in the science course.

Tardy Policy:

Every 3 tardies lowers the grade in a course by 1/11th (from an A- to a B+).
3 tardies can be redeemed with an hour after school at a mutually agreed upon time, within a reasonable time frame.

Food & Beverage Policy:

There is absolutely no food or beverage allowed in any science area (classroom, hallway, entry) at any time.

Course Materials:

Students are required to bring their science notebook, textbook, supplies, and student laptop to class each day as stipulated by the teacher. Science notebooks must be bound, composition style; must have the student's name clearly labeled on the front; and all work contained within must be in the student's own words.

Honesty:

Academic dishonesty is prohibited in all courses and can result in loss of credit. See the Student Handbook of Rights and Responsibilities for Shoreline District guidelines.

Safety Guidelines:

In order to maintain continued enrollment in a science course, all students must:

1. Wear personal protective equipment as directed
2. Follow all guidelines outlined on the lab safety handout and as directed by the teacher.
3. Conduct oneself in a responsible, mature, and safe manner
4. Refrain from bringing food or drink into the science classroom
5. Prepare oneself for lab by reading the directions prior to class

Classroom Conduct:

All science classes abide by the *Shorewood High School Discipline Code*, the *Shorewood Science Department Guidelines*, *Acceptable Usage Policies* for laptops, and individual teacher classroom guidelines. Copies of all these documents can be found online and on student laptops.
